# De La Salle University – Angelo King Institute for Economic and Business Studies AKI Research Grants For AY2018-2019

The DLSU-Angelo King Institute for Economic and Business Studies (DLSU-AKI) announces its call for submission of proposals on *Poverty Research, Food Research,* and *Research on Entrepreneurship and Family Business* for AY 2018-2019.

## Description

The Institutes invites empirically-based research proposals on: (i) **Poverty Research** (using the Community-Based Monitoring System Data Sets and/or Annual Poverty Indicator Survey), (ii) **Food Research**, and (iii) **Research on Entrepreneurship and Family Business**. These proposals must be implemented over a six-month timeframe.

Among the expected outputs are the following:

- a) Full research paper to be included in an AKI Book Project
- b) Presentation in an AKI Lecture Series or participation in the National CBMS Conference (for poverty research only)
- c) Policy Brief that will highlight the policy recommendations based on the key findings of the study. A three to four page policy paper will be published by the Institute as an AKI Policy Brief (ISSN 2094-3342).

Although not part of the expected outputs, all recipients of AKI research grants are encouraged to publish the results of their research in Scopus/Web of Science journals. The Institute will provide financial assistance in the process of publication.

## Eligibility

An applicant for the Research Grants is open to all <u>full-time faculty members</u> of <u>De La Salle University-Manila</u>.

#### **Awards**

<u>Five proposals</u> will be selected for each of the three research themes and each proposal will be awarded a <u>PHP120,000 grant</u>. All recipients of grants will be selected by a review committee of the Angelo King Institute.

# **Application Requirements**

All applications for Research Grants must include:

- 1. Information on the researcher (contact and background information, including current curriculum vitae) and co-researcher(s), if applicable.
- 2. Abstract of the proposed research project.
- 3. Statement of how the research advances the state of knowledge in the field.
- 4. Research proposal (limited to 7 single-spaced pages) that addresses the following:
  - a. Problem statement/policy issue and its importance
  - b. Theoretical or conceptual framework for the research
  - c. Review of literature
  - d. Research questions
  - e. Description of methodology including proposed dataset and criteria for selecting the sample, selection of variables and rationale for using them, and analytic techniques
  - f. References cited in the proposal

The deadline for proposals for AKI Research Grants is at 5:00pm on October 26, 2018, Friday.
